TOPICS:

- Grades 1 2: Write about one of the most important holidays in your heritage/culture and describe what you do for that holiday
- Grades 3 5: Design a brochure to introduce a place in Philadelphia that is connected and meaningful to your culture/heritage
- Grades 6 12: Make a video or slideshow autobiography which shows how your cultural heritage has influenced you and made you who you are today

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Asian American Students in Grades 1st - 12th

GUIDELINES:

- Writing submitted can be in any genre as long as it addresses the topic.
- Students who wish to write in their native languages will be entered into the "Writing in Native Language" category. The writings in students' native languages can be handwritten in grades 1st-5th.
- Review Committee will use the Pennsylvania Writing Rubrics to score each entry.
- All entries should be submitted with a **cover page** with the following information:
 - Name of student
 - Name of school, Grade level, Name of the writing instructor
 - Name and contact info (phone number or email address) of parents or guardians
